



Level of warning	Definition	Action	Notes
Flood Warning Live to the state of the stat	Flooding is expected. Immediate Action Required. Take action now to prevent water getting into your home, move family pets and valuables to a safe place. If caught in a flash flood, get to high ground. Stay away from flood water and don't take risks.	Call Floodline on 0345 988 1188 and key in quickdial number 192211 (Clwyd Left Bank) or 601005 (Kinmel Bay) for the times of high tides. Alternatively, look on the Natural Resources Wales website www.naturalresources.wales for the times of high tides. Consider activating the flood plan. If you have decided to activate the flood plan, perform evacuation procedures as shown in Section 7 (Page 9-10) and protective actions as shown in Section 8 (Page 11) as long as it is safe to do so. Consider one's own health and safety at all times and should not take any actions that may compromise their own or others safety. Contact the Emergency Services immediately if the situation requires it.	Be prepared to evacuate the site as quickly and as safely as possible before the time of high tide. Report any incidents of flooding to Natural Resources Wales and Conwy County Borough Council.

If a decision has been made to evacuate, contact Conwy County Borough Council / local bus companies to arrange transport from the flood risk area.	Arrange for pupils to be moved to a suitable location away from the flood risk area. This could be a rest centre already set up by Conwy County Borough Council. Once safely away from the flood risk area, inform parents / guardians that they can arrange to collect their children. This can be done through local media or another system. Keep a list of all pupils that have been collected by their parents / guardians. Liaise with Ysgol Y Foryd's lead person when deciding to evacuate the school; both schools will evacuate to Ysgol Emrys Ap Iwan in Abergele.
If the Clwyd Left Bank or Kinmel Bay Severe Flood Warning has been issued / conditions have deteriorated before evacuation from the flood risk area has occurred, contact the emergency services immediately to request assistance.	Ensure that pupils, staff members and visitors are moved to safe location and wait for the emergency services. Once everyone has moved to a safe location; re-take the registers, check welfare, and ensure that a First Aid Kit is available. Contact the emergency services immediately if there are any issues. Contact parents / guardians to inform them of the situation.
If the Clwyd Left Bank or Kinmel Bay remove Warning is issued / floodwater has receded, make sure that the site is safe prior to entering and beginning recovery actions.	Contact Local Authority to begin recovery actions to ensure that the school can reopen as soon as possible. If you have any issues with evacuation, ensure staff members are moved to a safe area and contact the emergency services immediately to request assistance. Consider your own health and safety at all times, and do not take any actions that may compromise your own or others safety. Co-operate with the emergency services.	Report any incidents of flooding to Natural Resources Wales and Conwy County Borough Council.

Ensure floodwater has receded and that the site is safe prior to entering and beginning recovery actions.	Take photographic / video evidence of any damage prior to contacting your insurance company. Report any incidents of flooding to Natural Resources Wales and Conwy County Borough Council.
