<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find out the names of all the islands around the British Isles. Create a picture, a diagram or a table to list them. Can they be grouped together – size, nationality (Wales, Scotland, Ireland or England), location (Irish Sea, English Channel, North Sea). <i>You could use Google Sheets or Google Slides for this.</i> • Research and find out the names of the 10 biggest islands and the 10 smallest islands from around the world. <i>You could use Google Sheets or Google Slides for this.</i> • Imagine your dream shelter or den....what would it be like? Draw a plan of your dream den/shelter and label the items you would have in it. • When you have finally built your dream den/shelter, where would it be? Make a picture of what you would see if you were sat in the doorway to your dream den/shelter. <i>You could cut and paste pictures and create a collage on Google Slides.</i> • What delicious snack or meal could you make on a camp fire? Maybe you have a favourite meal that you have when you go camping. Write a set of instructions (a recipe) for how to create your delicious camp fire meal. • Imagine you wanted to make a friend (a pen pal) but the only way of introducing yourself would be to post a message in a bottle. What details would you include? Your message must be factual, interesting and limited to only 50 words! <i>Use Google Docs to write your message.</i> • Desert Island Luxuries – We all know the kind of things you would need to survive on a desert island – food, water, shelter. Think about the 5 LUXURY items that you would like to have with you. Write down what they are and why you would want them with you. <i>Use Google Docs or Google Slides.</i> • The Island Games are held every 2 years.
