## **Re: Block of Intensive Swimming Sessions**

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

As you will already be aware from the dates sent home previously, intensive Swimming lessons for Years 3 and 4 will be held next week each morning and the following week too. The only day that Years 3 and 4 will not go swimming during this two week block will be on Thursday 26th June as this is the whole school Transition/move up day.

All year 5 and 6 learners will go every morning for two weeks during the weeks beginning 30<sup>th</sup> June and the 7<sup>th</sup> July. As we have a Staff Training Day on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June, this is the only day during the two week block that Year 5 and 6 won't be going swimming.

It is essential that all children attend, as personal survival is at the core of the series of lessons and various bodies of water can be found in the local area namely the sea, a river and lakes. It is important that we work together to improve your child's swimming skills at all levels. If you or your child are particularly nervous, please do speak to your child's class teacher who can offer reassurance and help accordingly. There is no capacity at school for any child to stay behind and miss these sessions.
