Language, Literacy and Communication

Pupils will have the opportunity to write for a variety of purposes including script writing, report writing and formal emailing. The children will also take part in a number of drama sessions and Mantle activities where we will focus on speaking and listening as part of collaborative talk.

In Welsh sessions, children will develop their vocabulary and dictionary skills and will be reading and writing non-fiction texts on animals.



Mathematics & Numeracy

Year 3: Number and place value, mental addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, measurement, shape, fractions, and problem solving.

Year 4: Number and place value, mental and written addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, percentages, decimals, problem solving and measurement.



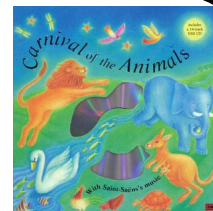
Humanities

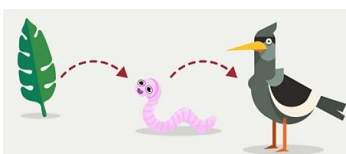
Expressive Arts
